ECC handlers must enter a minimum of 4 birds to be able to handle out of area birds. Entry fees are 4 birds for \$ 100.00 and \$ 25.00 for each bird after that. You can enter as many birds as you want.

Out of area fanciers should contact the loft of their choice to make arrangements for placement. Maximum placement per loft is 20 out-of-area birds. Once a loft has reached maximum amount birds will be placed at next choice, or placed by the committee in available lofts. If one wants birds placed in a certain loft it is important to make arrangements as early as possible. Handlers can only accept 4 birds from one loft, if you have more they have to be placed in another loft. A list of the available handlers and entry forms will be available on the ECC website. (www.eastcourserpc.ca)

Birds will be accepted from February 01, 2010, till May 31, 2010.

Cheques are to be made payable to the "East Course Combine" and accompanied by an entry form stating the loft of your choice and band numbers, if possible. Band numbers can be sent later with birds when delivering birds. If birds go to more than one loft you may call and we will deliver them to the proper loft.

First out of area bird clocked will be awarded \$ 500.00 with no cut, or split. Out of area birds and in area birds will be competing weekly for their own \$ 100.00 prize leading up to main race.

Breeders can follow the progress of their birds on our website.

Submit your entries early to get the birds in the loft of your choice.
